*No data will be transferred outside the European Union.*

*Your personal data will be kept for a period of 1 month after the end of the conference.*

*You have the following rights regarding the use of your data:*

- the right to object: you can object to the processing of your data at any time and have the right to withdraw your consent*
- the right to access and rectify your data*
- the right to erasure - the right to restricted use when your data is not necessary or is no longer useful*
- the right to portability: to communicate your data to the person of your choice.*
